SPECIAL MEETING TO ACT UPON ORDINANCE 13-10, 14-10, 15-10, 16-10 AND RESOLUTION 1637 – ALSO TO ADOPT A PROPOSAL TO CLEAN UP GORLEY ST. BOTTOMS

President Donato called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Clerk, Brian Watkins. All members of council were present including Mayor Rieger and Auditor Jody Dunlap.

1st Reading ó Ordinance 13-10 ó AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF UHRICHSVILLE TO ENTER INTO NO COST MUTUAL AID AGREEMENTS WITH TUSCARAWAS COUNTY AND OTHER MUNICIPALITIES IN TUSCARAWAS COUNTY TO PARTICIPATE IN A SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTIC (SWAT) FORCE, AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY

Discussion on Ordinance 13-10:

- Mr. Gyurko wanted clarification on how the cost of weapons and ammo was split up ó Mayor Rieger told him that all communities are responsible for their own.
- The ordinance that was read stated the öChief of Policeö rather than the öMayorö ó members of council along with the Mayor agreed that the words chief of police should be replaced with Mayor.

He then would level the existing dirt piles. This work would take approximately 50 hours to complete and he would charge the city \$5,500.00. The money for the project will come out the fund that was designated for the demolition of the city auto building.
