

UHRICHSVILLE CITY COUNCIL

March 25, 2010

President Donato called the meeting to order at 7 PM. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Council Clerk ProTem, Mary Ellen Campbell. ROLL CALL showed the following members present: Mr Haney, Mr Peterson, Mr Culbertson, Mrs Davis, Mrs Cottis. Mr Gyurko is out of town, Miss Dunlap not available.

MINUTES: of the last meeting were accepted as presented on a motion by Mrs Cottis seconded by Mrs Davis. ROLL CALL: Mrs Cottis yea, Mrs Davis yea, Mr Haney yea, Mr Peterson yea, Mr Culbertson yea.

President Donato welcomed and introduced Brian Watkins who has been selected to serve for the 4 year term till December 31, 2013. Brian is a graduate of Claymont High School and The College of Wooster. He asked for a motion to accept this appointment. Motion was made by Mrs Cottis, seconded by Mr Culbertson. ROLL CALL: Mrs Cottis yea, Mr Culbertson yea, Mrs Davis yea, Mr Haney yea, Mr Peterson yea.

VISITORS: Mike Jones of Quicksall and Assoc gave an update on the 2nd street project. Because of high water, they are working at the Water Street end of the job. On Wednesday, March 30, 10 AM there will be a meeting in the Council Chambers to update everyone on the progress of the project.

He asked if any letters were received in support of the boat ramp project. The application is due April 1st. The mayor has letters in his office and residents can still send them in to be turned in later.

REPORTS:

DIRECTOR OF CITY SERVICES: Mr Angelozzi reported that Spring Clean-UP will be the weeks of April 5 and April 12. Pick up will be Monday Wednesday and Friday. No tires, electronics, batteries or paint. Residents must call and items must be at the curbside.

FEMA has told min that we must be compliant by 7/22/10 regarding the Flood insurance program. He attended a class ad ODNR. Uhrichsville was updated in 2006. Needs a copy of the Ordinance from 11-06.

The Census Bureau contacted him and he needs a copy of the ordinance where the Property for Claymont High School was annexed. Former Clerk, Mrs Davis said she thought it was a resolution and would help look for it.

MAYOR: The Water Park will be offering a discount to children 17 and under and live within the corporation. It will be \$3.00 off. There will be a sign up time and they will be required to show proof of address. The Village of Dennison will be offering the same discount to their children and the Village will pay the City on a weekly basis, the \$3.00 discount. More information is forthcoming.

The Mayor complimented the police on the safe handling of the incident on Trenton Avenue this week. The Dennison, Gnadenhutten, and Sherriff dept helped also.

-- He received a phone call from Julie Tripodi of Warm n Cozy who would like to be sworn in as our humane officer. He passed the information on the Law Director to check into. We do not have a position in the city for a humane officer.

-- Received a list of prior year's property tax in the Amount of \$295,279.00 from the Tuscarawas County Treasurer. (Some of this would belong to Claymont Schools) They will begin the process to try to collect these taxes.

-- Also received a list from RITA in the amount of \$59,000.00. They also are in the process of collecting.

-- Has a concern about the Security of the City Building. Would like to meet with the building committee to come up with a solution. President Donato will put it in the Zoning Committee.

Mrs Cottis asked the Mayor if he knew anything about 8922 Dayö. He said he knew it was September 22 and will give her more information when it is available.

LAW DIRECTOR The Ordinance committee had asked for an ordinance on License and Fees. He has submitted a rough draft and asked that they review it and make any changes and corrections.
