

UHRICHSVILLE ORDINANCE 10-2010

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 1501 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE AND TO ADOPT THE OHIO FIRE CODE (THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE) AS ADOPTED BY THE FIRE MARSHAL OF THE STATE OF OHIO PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF OHIO REVISED CODE CHAPTER 3737 AND SPECIFICALLY ORC CODE SECTION 3737.82 AND THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF THE STATE OF OHIO AS AUTHORIZED IN ORC 3737.82 AND SUCCEEDING ADDITIONS OF THE FIRE CODE AS ADOPTED BY THE OHIO FIRE MARSHAL

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code section 3737.82 has authorized the State of Ohio Fire Marshal to adopt a state fire code which shall consist of rules relating to all aspects of fire safety; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Marshal has adopted the Ohio Fire Code which is based upon the International Fire Code; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Fire Code has been adopted pursuant to the Ohio Rules of Administrative procedure and will be periodically amended to further fire safety; and

WHEREAS, the City of Uhrichsville and the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Uhrichsville will be advanced by the adoption of the Ohio Fire Code as presently adopted by the Ohio Fire Marshal and as amended periodically in the future.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, OHIO:

I.

Section 1501.01

The Ohio Fire Code as adopted by the Ohio Fire Marshal pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 3737 and section 3737.2 and the Ohio Administrative Code as presently constituted and as amended is adopted as the Fire Code of the City of Uhrichsville.

Section 1501.02

One copy of the Ohio Fire Code for the City shall be kept by the Auditor and by the Fire Department.

Section 1501.99

Any person, firm, corporation or other legal entity who violates any provision of the code (Ohio Fire Code as adopted and amended periodically by the Ohio Fire Marshal pursuant to Ohio Revised Code chapter 3737 and section 3737.82 and the Ohio Administrative Code) or who fails to comply with any order issued pursuant to any section thereof, shall be guilty of a minor misdemeanor on the first offense, a fourth degree misdemeanor on the second offense, a third degree misdemeanor on the third offense, a second degree misdemeanor on the fourth offense and a first degree misdemeanor on the fifth offense.

II.

That this ORDINANCE is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary of the preservation of public peace, health, and safety for the City of Uhrichsville and its inhabitants, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the members appointed or elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. The BOCA Basic Fire Prevention Code mentioned in Chapter 1501 as adopted in 1984 no longer exists and the State Fire Code has been adopted by the Ohio Fire Marshal and Uhrichsville needs to immediately adopt and therefore constitutes an emergency.
