**RESOLUTION 1708  
RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE CURRENT  
INCOME TAX LEVEL AT A RATE OF ONE-QUARTER PERCENT (1/4%). THIS TAX IS IN  
ADDITION TO THE ONE AND THREE-QUARTERS PERCENT (1 AND 3/4%) INCOME TAX  
LEVIED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (b) OF 181.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF  
UHRICHSVILLE AND OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 718.01.**

**UHRICHSVILLE EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 3-14  
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 181.02 (a) AND (b) BY THE ADDITION OF  
SUBSECTION (c) TO INCREASE AND LEVY AND ADDITIONAL TAX UPON THE EARNINGS AT  
THE RATE OF ONE-QUARTER PERCENT (1/4%). THIS TAX IS IN ADDITION TO THE ONE AND  
THREE-QUARTERS PERCENT (1 AND 3/4%) INCOME TAX LEVIED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (a)  
AND (b) OF 181.02.**

WHEREAS, in 1973 council adopted a city income tax of one percent (1%) and in 1983 council enacted an ordinance to increase the city income tax by three-quarters of a percent (3/4%) which increase was approved by the voters; and

WHEREAS, in 1999 council amended the 1973 one percent income tax by a real and then reenactment of the one percent by ordinance and which increase was approved by the voters of Uhrichsville; and

WHEREAS, to continue to provide adequate services to the people of the city of Uhrichsville, it is necessary to acquire additional revenues and to increase the city income tax; and

WHEREAS, the increase in the city income tax by an additional one-quarter of one percent (1/4%) commencing on July 1, 2014 will enhance the health, safety and welfare of the people of the city of Uhrichsville.
