

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2-18
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CURRENT CITY INCOME TAX
ORDINANCE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE REGIONAL INCOME TAX
AUTHORITY (R.I.T.A.)

WHEREAS, The Ohio Legislature has again amended the Ohio Revised Code and placed further burdens on the City of Uhrichsville with changes contained in House Bill 49.

WHEREAS, The City must update its Income Tax Code for the third time in so many years;

WHEREAS, many municipalities in Ohio have challenged the Constitutionality of the House Bill 49 in Court, the City will amend its Ordinance and Income Tax Code once again at the recommendation of R.I.T.A.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE UHRICHSVILLE COUNCIL:

I.

The changes suggested by R.I.T.A., hereby attached are hereby adopted in full. Any discrepancies between the existing Ordinances and Uhrichsville Codes are overruled by this Ordinance. A copy of those suggested changes are hereby attached.

II.

That is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with all applicable open meeting laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including open meeting requirements.

III.

This Ordinance is declared an emergency ordinance necessary to preserve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Uhrichsville and shall take effect immediately upon its passage. Otherwise, it shall be effective on the earliest date allowed by law. The need to regulate recreational vehicles for the betterment of the neighborhoods constitutes an emergency.
