SECTION 3: TheCity Auditor is hereby authorized to draw warrants on the City Treasurer for payment from and of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certificates and vouchers, therefore, approved by the board of officers authorized by law to approve the same of an ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditure, provided that no warrant shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except the persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law or ordinance provided further, that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon approval of a two-thirds (2/3) vote of Council for Items or purposes other than those covered by other specific appropriations herein made.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency for the public peace, health, safety and welfare due to the fact that the appropriations must be delivered to the County Auditor's Office in order to issue warrants.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.
