

RESOLUTION NO. 1779

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO
REDUCE THE VOTER APPROVED 2.85 MILL AMBULANCE LEVY
BY CERTAIN MILLAGE.**

WHEREAS, passage was obtained of the city of Uhrichsville's 2.85 Mill Levy for the purpose of operating and providing ambulance service in the city; and

WHEREAS, Council does not wish to exact from the City taxpayers any additional tax revenues due to the oversight by another agency, and has the ability to roll back the amount of mileage generated by said 2.85 Mill Levy.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, as follows:
