RESOLUTION # <u>/852</u> A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED OHIO HOUSE BILL 54 AND THE INCREASE OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Uhrichsville supports proposed Ohio House Bill 54 which would increase local government funding from 1.66% to 3.53%.

WHEREAS, the current levels of funding received from the Ohio General Assembly does not provide enough revenue for local government services.

WHEREAS, the City of Uhrichsville previously received a total amount of \$350,000 from the Ohio General Assembly in local government funding in the fiscal year 2005.

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly has cut local government funds greatly since the fiscal year 2005.

WHEREAS, the passage of Ohio House Bill 54 would contribute to and benefit the public safety and overall quality of life in the City of Uhrichsville.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Uhrichsville and the Ohio General Assembly should support each other and work together to improve the quality of life in the City of Uhrichsville and the State of Ohio.

WHEREAS, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION 1: That the Council of the City of Uhrichsville reaffirms its support for proposed Ohio House Bill 54 and wishes to see local government funding increased to 3.53%.

SECTION 2: That the Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to forward this resolution to the Ohio General Assembly and Ohio Governor Mike DeWine.
