

RESOLUTION NO. 1860

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO DISPOSE OF SPECIFIC EXCESS PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT VALUED AT AN AMOUNT LESS THAN \$1,000.00

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Fire Department have advised Council for the City of Uhrichsville that the Fire Department is in need of disposing of unneeded property, equipment and inventory; and

WHEREAS, Council for the City of Uhrichsville, based upon such advice, has determined that the Fire Department has property, equipment and inventory that is no longer needed for City purposes, and a need exists to dispose of such unneeded property, equipment and inventory.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, OHIO that:

SECTION 1. The Ordinances and Resolutions of the City are silent regarding procedures for disposing of surplus property, which means that the City must follow Ohio statutes regarding the disposal of surplus property.






