Mr. Inantison moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, TUSCARAWAS County, Ohio; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the MEMBERS OF COUNCIL of the CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, TUSCARAWAS County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation for the benefit of THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, OHIO for the purpose of providing ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both

LEVY IS A RENEWAL

at a rate not exceeding 2.85 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.285 (twenty eight and ½ cents) for each one hundred dollars of valuation for 5 YEARS COMMENCING IN 2020, FIRST DUE IN CALENDAR YEAR 2021.

Certificate of Estimated Property Tax Revenue

The county auditor of <u>Tuscarawas</u> County, Ohio, does hereby certify the following:

- 1. On October 31, 2019, the taxing authority of the City of Uhrichsville (political subdivision name) certified a copy of its resolution or ordinance adopted October 24, 2019, requesting the county auditor to certify the current tax valuation of the subdivision and the amount of revenue that would be produced by two and eighty-five hundredths (2.85), to levy a tax outside the 10-mill limitation for providing ambulance service, emergency medical service, or both purposes pursuant to Revised Code §5705.19(U), to be placed on the ballot at the March 17, 2020, election. - 2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming the tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$130.786.
- 3. The total tax valuation of the subdivision used in calculating the estimated property tax revenue is \$57,242,210.

Instructions

- 1. "Total tax valuation" includes the taxable value of all real property in the subdivision as indicated on the tax list most recently certified for collection and estimates of the taxable value of personal and public utility personal property for the first year the levy will be collected as set forth on the worksheets prescribed in conjunction with this form. If the subdivision is located in more than one county, the home county auditor (where the greatest taxable value of the subdivision is located) shall obtain the assistance of the other county auditors to establish the total tax valuation of the subdivision.
- 2. For purposes of this certification, "subdivision" includes any agency, board, commission or other authority authorized to request a taxing authority to submit a tax levy on its behalf.
- 3. "Levy type" includes the following: (1) additional, (2) renewal, (3) renewal with an increase, (4) renewal with a decrease, (5) replacement, (6) replacement with an increase and (7) replacement with a decrease levies.
- 4. Please file this certificate with the subdivision as soon as possible, so the taxing authority can pass a resolution to proceed not later than 90 days before the election.
