

**RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE CURRENT INCOME TAX LEVEL AT A RATE OF ONE-QUARTER PERCENT (1/4%). THIS TAX IS IN ADDITION TO THE ONE AND THREE-QUARTERS PERCENT (1 AND 3/4%) INCOME TAX LEVIED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (a) AND (b) OF 181.02 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF UHRICHVILLE AND OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 718.01**

M. R. Peterson moved the adoption of the following Resolution:

**WHEREAS**, The amount of taxes which may be raised within the current 1 ¾% limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said City of Uhrichsville, Tuscarawas County, Ohio;

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code Sec. 718.01 authorizes an income tax in excess of the current income tax for general operating purposes;

**WHEREAS**, a tax levy for for this purpose is authorized under §718.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Article XVIII, Section 4 of the Ohio Constitution; and,

**WHEREAS**, a levy must be placed before the voters at the May 6, 2014 primary election;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Uhrichsville, Tuscarawas County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the current income tax of 1 ¾% for the benefit of City of Uhrichsville for the purpose of General Operating Expenses for the City, together with other general operating expenses, which levy is an

**RESOLVED**, That said income tax levy be levied in the current year, commencing in 2014 after the election at the earliest date, if a majority of the electors voting thereon vote in favor thereof; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, That the Council Clerk of this City of Uhrichsville be and is hereby directed to certify a copy of the Resolution to the Board of Election, Tuscarawas County, Ohio and notify said Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying said tax to be given as required by law.

**RESOLVED**, That pursuant to O.R.C. §718.01, the Board of Elections of Tuscarawas County, Ohio is hereby directed to conduct the election on said tax rate increase with the ballot to be in substantially in the following form:

SHALL THE ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A ONE-FOURTH PERCENT INCREASE (.25%) LEVY ON INCOME, BEGGINNING EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE CONTINUED EFFICIENT OPERATION OF ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, OHIO BE PASSED:






