

RESOLUTION NO. 1719

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMS AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Uhrichsville is planning to make capital improvements to Eastport Avenue (Eastport Avenue Improvement Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Uhrichsville:

**Section 1:** The Mayor of Uhrichsville is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

**Section 2:** The Mayor of Uhrichsville is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

**Section 3:** That this Resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of public peace, health, and safety for the City of Uhrichsville and its inhabitants and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
