

RESOLUTION # 1818

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PROPOSED OHIO HOUSE BILL 538

WHEREAS, the City Council of Uhrichsville supports proposed Ohio House Bill 538 which restores local government funding to the levels of the fiscal year 2005.

WHEREAS, the current levels of funding received from the Ohio General Assembly does not provide enough funding for local governments.

WHEREAS, the City of Uhrichsville previously received a total amount of \$350,000 from the Ohio General Assembly in local government funding in the fiscal year 2005.

WHEREAS, the Ohio General Assembly has cut local government funds greatly since the fiscal year 2005.

WHEREAS, the passage of Ohio House Bill 538 would contribute to and benefit the public safety and overall quality of life in the City of Uhrichsville.




