

ORDINANCE NO. 69-21 (formally 54-37)

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT ALL CALLS FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES GENERATED FROM PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE BE MADE THROUGH TUSCARAWAS COUNTY'S 911 SYSTEM

WHEREAS, members of the Council for the City of Uhrichsville have recently discussed and deliberated the issue of persons and businesses not contacting the Tuscarawas County 911 System when placing calls for emergency medical services.

WHEREAS, members of the Council for the City of Uhrichsville have determined that it would be beneficial to the residents of the City of Uhrichsville for the Council of the City of Uhrichsville to enact legislation requiring all calls for emergency medical services made from locations within the territorial limits of the City of Uhrichsville be made through Tuscarawas County's 911 System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. All calls for emergency medical services made from locations within the territorial limits of the City of Uhrichsville must be made through Tuscarawas County's 911 System.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall become effective at the first time permitted by Ohio law.
