

RESOLUTION NO. 1912

**A RESOLUTION CREATING THE ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUND
FOR HANDLING OF FUNDS RECEIVED BY THE CITY FROM THE
ONEOHIO OPIOID SETTLEMENT**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has reached an \$808 Million agreement with the three largest distributors of opioids, which is known as the OneOhio Opioid Settlement; and

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has developed the OneOhio plan, which is a mechanism to ensure that any money from a negotiated settlement is distributed fairly to the communities hit hardest by the opioid crisis; and

WHEREAS, the City of Uhrichsville anticipates receiving monies from the OneOhio Opioid Settlement; and

WHEREAS, State law requires subdivisions receiving funds to create a new, restricted fund for receipt and expenditure of funds received from the OneOhio Opioid Settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF UHRICHSVILLE, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

SECTION 1: The City of Uhrichsville Council hereby establishes the OneOhio Opioid Settlement Fund, as a restricted fund, for the receipt and expenditure of funds received by the City from the OneOhio Opioid Settlement.


