



Tuscarawas County: Construction Update

Current and upcoming road closures and restrictions for Tuscarawas County are listed below. Click on each route to see the location at OHGO.com.

State Route 39 resurfacing project east of New Philadelphia: Work is underway to resurface nearly five miles of State Route 39 from the eastern New Philadelphia corporation limit to Roswell. Traffic will be maintained with flaggers. The completion date is October 31, 2025.

U.S. Route 250/McCauley Drive major concrete rehabilitation project: A project to remove and replace the concrete pavement on U.S. Route 250 at the McCauley Drive intersection and on the westbound off-ramp from U.S. Route 36 to U.S. Route 250. The significant traffic impacts for this project are now complete. The contractor has remaining work to complete; however, normal traffic patterns have resumed through this area. The overall completion date is October 31, 2025.

Village of Sugarcreek Maple and Church Street improvements: A project to replace sidewalks along Maple Street and Church Street is underway. The project includes sidewalk work along Maple Street from Church Street to S. Broadway Street, and Church Street from W. Main Street to Maple Street. Throughout the project, Maple Street and Church Street will be closed to traffic while this work is being completed. Access to homes in this area will be maintained throughout the project. The completion date is October 31, 2025.

State Route 800 bridge repair project: A project to repair a State Route 800 bridge over the Tuscarawas River. One traffic lane is maintained via temporary traffic signals, with the roadway width restriction being 11 feet, and a 5-foot bike lane will be maintained. The completion date is September 30, 2025.
