Street Department Laborer 1

General Statement of Duties:

Under general supervision of the Street Dept. Superintendent, the street dept. laborer performs general manual work. Some training or experience required.

Examples of work:

- Maintains City Property using riding mowers, push mowers and weed eaters.
- Removes snow from City streets.
- Plants sod and grass seed as needed.
- Paints equipment and small buildings.
- Assists in maintaining traffic signs, including installation and replacement. Trims tree limbs around traffic signs and City right of ways using a chain saw.
- Assists in striping road lines, crosswalks, and lane division indicators.
- Cleans gutters, culverts, storm sewers, and other drainage structures.
- Assists in loading and unloading stone, gravel, dirt, asphalt, and mechanical equipment.
- Assists in the maintenance of City streets using both hot and cold asphalt by shoveling mix from the truck, placing in hole and tampering.
- Performs a variety of other manual work in connection with the maintenance and construction of sidewalks, streets, and storm sewers, and other related projects.
- Light building maintenance and janitorial duties.
- Cleans vehicles and equipment.
- Empties trash receptacles and landscapes as needed.
- Any other duties as assigned.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Willingness to perform routine manual work and accepts job directives respectfully.
- Ability to lift heavy articles and can maintain stamina.
- Ability to understand simple oral instructions.
- Mechanical aptitude.
- Ability to read and write, completion of standard grade school course and has a High School Graduation diploma or equivalency.

Required Certificates and Licenses:

- Possession of a valid Ohio Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
- May be required to pass a drug and alcohol screening.
